Introducing..

PETER JENSEN

Peter Jensen is a warm and engaging speaker born in Sydney in 1943. He was educated at Bellevue Hill Public School and The Scots College. After being what he describes as 'a failure in the law', he entered Moore Theological College in 1966.



Years later Peter was the Principal of Moore College in Sydney before becoming Anglican Archbishop of Sydney. He retired from the latter role in 2013 but until this year continued to be General Secretary of a world-wide Anglican movement called Gafcon, set up to defend and proclaim the gospel especially in areas where the churches have become compromised. He also lectures in various theological colleges and speaks in churches and conventions around Australia. He is the husband of Christine and they have 5 children and 25 grandchildren.

Peter has published a number of books and articles.

What is the purpose of the Convention?

The purpose of the Keswick Convention is to provide people of North Queensland with the opportunity to hear well gifted and experienced speakers address the issue of living a holy and victorious Christian life in this present world. 

PETER FRANCIS

Peter Francis is Principal of Malyon College and lectures in the areas of Missions, Old Testament and Pastoral Studies. Peter is married to Wendy who is the Director of the Centre for Human Dignity. Together they have 3 children and 10 grandchildren. After a 10-year career as a high school teacher, Peter entered into Pastoral ministry at Cleveland Baptist, having earned his Master of Divinity through Trinity Theological College (USA). Over a period of 22 years Peter pastored at Cleveland Baptist, Beenleigh Baptist and the City Tabernacle Baptist Church, as well as being involved in numerous short-term missions in places such as PNG, Bangladesh, Thailand, Cambodia, Vietnam, Solomon Islands, South America and Belarus. He has also given two years' service as a Regional Consultant with Queensland Baptists and has served on various mission boards such as the Far East Broadcasting Company and Global Interaction. Peter has been on the full-time faculty of Malyon College since 2011. His theological studies include a Master of Divinity, a Graduate in Theology, a Master of Arts in Theology and a Doctor of Ministry in which he explored factors impacting the missional rejuvenation of inner city churches.

WENDY FRANCIS

Wendy Francis is the Director of the Centre for Human Dignity in Australia, an initiative of the Australian Christian Lobby. She is a recognised Australian spokesperson for the rights of women and children and an effective campaigner against sexual exploitation in all its forms. Wendy's professional experience includes managerial positions at Griffith University and Queensland Baptists. In 2010 Wendy commenced a movement "Outdoor Advertising Should Be G Rated", contributing to various inquiries and to laws being introduced to stop offensive messaging on Australian roads. Wendy is a Director and Board Member of Samaritan's Purse Australia, Billy Graham Evangelistic Association Australia and Vision Media Australia. Wendy has travelled to countries such as Vietnam, Thailand, Bangladesh and Cambodia where she has seen first-hand projects that rescue women and children from sex slavery and provide literacy projects amongst rural women. She has been married to her husband Peter for 39 years. They have 3 children and 10 grandchildren.

GOODSEED



GoodSeed provides tools and training to help Bible believers explain the gospel in a way that makes profound sense. Though the tools were originally designed for people who have absolutely no knowledge of the Bible, we have found that whether you have been saved for 3 days or 33 years, the GoodSeed resources can be instrumental in building confidence in the Word of God and boldness in faith. Our key tools are patterned after the explanation of the gospel that Jesus gave to the disciples on the road to Emmaus. They start at Creation and move progressively through the Old Testament to the New Testament where we understand who Jesus is and what he did on the Cross. This is all for the purpose of explaining the gospel message clearly.
