Introducing...

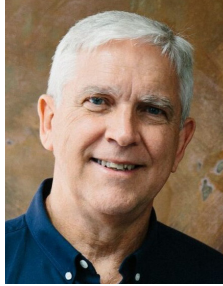
PETER FRANCIS

Peter has been married to Wendy for 46 years, and together they have three married children and eleven grandchildren.

After a 10-year career as a high school teacher, Peter became a Baptist minister, pastoring three Baptist churches over a 21-year period. In 2011 Peter took on a fulltime teaching role with Malyon Theological College, where he also served as the principal for seven years before retiring from that role at the end of 2024. At the start of 2025, Peter and Wendy launched their own ministry called Truth That Transforms (truththattransforms.com.au). This ministry provides a platform for their continued wider ministry. Over many years Peter and Wendy have engaged in numerous short-term missions in places as diverse as Bangladesh, Thailand, Cambodia, Vietnam, Vanuatu, The Solomons, Bolivia, Paraguay, Belarus and Lesotho, South Africa.

Peter continues to lecture part-time for one of the AUT (Australian University of Theology) colleges and maintains an ongoing wider preaching and Bible teaching ministry in a diverse range of churches, conferences and missional settings. He is also the Chair of the Lachlan Macquarie Institute.

His passion continues to be the equipping of the saints for the work of the ministry with a particular focus on the raising up of a new generation of gospel-centred workers.

NEIL BERNARD

Neil has spoken at QTKC on two previous occasions. He is currently involved in a preaching and teaching ministry. Every Sunday Neil preaches in various, predominantly Baptist churches in and around Brisbane. He is also a part-time Pastor at Bridgeman Baptist Church, a large suburban church on the north-side of the city. This involves preaching twice a month at their mid-week Seniors' Service and some Pastoral responsibilities. For 13 years now, Neil has been teaching ethnic students every second Saturday who are studying for a Diploma in Christian Ministry and Theology. English is not their first language and they mainly come from Africa, Myanmar, Samoa and New Zealand. Neil is also a regular guest lecturer at Capernwray Bible School Australia, where he was formerly Principal, 2001 - 2012. Neil also worked alongside Peter Francis at Malyon College, 2012 - 2017. In his spare time Neil enjoys travel and photography, and last year was awarded Amateur Grand Champion at the Pine Rivers Show. Neil loves presenting scripture so people can have a closer walk with Jesus.

Wendy's elective speaking topic will be:-

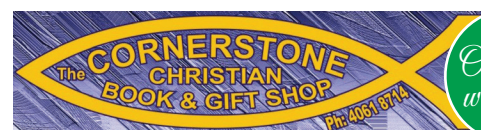
